
Wednesday, Dec 4 from 5:00-6:00pm - Filling Gift Bags (225 of them!)

This Advent, you will find an Advent Wreath Prayer Board in our Narthex, and on our Facebook page!


Even as we prepare to welcome the Christ Child once again this Christmas, our hearts are filled with joys and concerns--large and small.
