

What is Per Capita?

Per Capita is the per-member cost for being Presbyterian. We invite members to contribute this amount, in addition to your regular donations. Per Capita for 2024 is \$36.35. This amount is sent away to Pittsburgh Presbytery, the Synod of the Trinity and the General Assembly of the PC(USA). East Union Church is responsible for Per Capita on each member, each year. The total cost to the church is a bit over \$8,000.

With the end of this year fast-approaching, we want to remind everyone there are only a few more months to cover the per capita fee for 2024. It can be paid in increments and at any time throughout the year. Per Capita can be paid online or by specifying 'per capita' on your contribution envelope.
